



CALL FOR PAPERS

The journal *Computational Linguistics in Bulgaria* is a newly established annual open access journal (dcl.bas.bg/jclib/) published by the Department of Computational Linguistics at the Institute for Bulgarian Language of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences.

The journal *Computational Linguistics in Bulgaria* publishes articles from all areas of theoretical computational linguistics and currently available resources, datasets and technologies for natural language processing and artificial intelligence. The focus is on new approaches and methods, especially with regard to their application to **small and low-resource languages such as Bulgarian**, in order to bridge the gap between large and small languages in terms of language technologies.

The journal invites submissions for its first issue reflecting cutting-edge research in the field of computational linguistics, focusing on Bulgarian and other Slavic languages, but also presenting new theories, datasets and technologies that can be applied to many languages.

The deadline for submission of papers is 31 March 2025.

Submitted articles are subjected to **double-blind peer review** via a free publication management system. Each article is reviewed by at least two experts in the field (and subfield) of computational linguistics.

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
