

Computational Linguistics in Bulgaria is a newly established annual open access journal published by the Department of Computational Linguistics at the Institute for Bulgarian Language of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences.

The journal aims to reflect the growing significance of language technologies in the digital age and to showcase cutting-edge research in computational linguistics in Bulgaria and internationally.

Computational Linguistics in Bulgaria features research on all areas of theoretical computational linguistics, as well as on currently available resources, datasets, and technologies for natural language processing and artificial intelligence.

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The journal focuses on innovative approaches and methods, particularly those applicable to small and low-resource languages such as Bulgarian, with the aim of bridging the gap between large and small languages in the field of language technologies.

The journal invites submissions for its second issue in 2026.

The deadline for submission of papers is 31 March 2026.

Submitted articles undergo a double-blind peer review process. Each submission is evaluated by at least two independent experts specialising in the relevant subfields of computational linguistics.

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
